Dog Licenses:

If you need a dog license and have not purchased it from your veterinarian, the treasurer will be able to sell one with a current proof of rabies vaccination and proof of neutering. If paying by mail, **please send a stamped self-addressed envelope for the treasurer to return the license.** If possible, please also include a copy of last year's license and/ or the dog's name, breed, age and color. The cost is Male/Female \$30.00 and Neutered dogs \$10.00. After February 29th, licenses are doubled in cost and must be purchased at the county.

Fire/Burning Information

Before you burn limbs, brush, stumps, leaves or grass; you must obtain a burning permit from the Village of Ovid by either calling 989-834-5550 or stopping by their office at 114 E. Front St., Ovid. They will need the address where the burn is located and a cell number of someone on site. They will also need the material that is being burnt. It is given is a four day increment. Items not allowed to be burnt are demolition debris, auto parts or construction materials. Fire calls made to any fires without a burning permit are charged accordingly.
