

A regular meeting of the Middlebury Township Planning Commission was held May 3, 2007 at the Middlebury Township hall at 7627 W. M-21 Ovid, Michigan. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Richard Givens at 7:40 p.m. with the pledge to the flag.

The oath of office was given by Givens to Carolyn Stevens and Audrey Sovis. A motion was made by Givens and supported by C. Stevens to appoint A. Sovis as secretary; all ayes, no nays, carried.

Givens, C. Stevens, A. Sovis along with Glen Nethaway and David Sovis were present. Gene Ruess and Mike Stevens were absent.

A motion was made by D. Sovis and supported by Nethaway to approve the minutes of the April 5, 2007 Middlebury Township Planning Commission meeting; all ayes, no nays, carried. A motion was made by A. Sovis and supported by C. Stevens to approve the agenda as presented; all ayes, no nays, carried.

There were no scheduled comments or public comments.

Givens reported on correspondence he received from the Shiawassee County Community Development regarding private roads; he said a final decision was made that there will be no private roads. All roads will be built by Shiawassee County Road Commission standards.

Unfinished Business: In regard to the Jeffery Potter zoning issue, the overall opinion of this board has not changed. The board is in agreement with what the county has handed down.

In regard to the County land use plan, the consensus of this board is in favor of the plan as presented.

A motion was made by Glen and supported by C. Stevens to appoint Gene Ruess as Vice-Chair of the Planning Commission; all ayes, no nays, carried.

At 9:10 p.m. the meeting was adjourned by Chairman Givens.
