

**04-2016 RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING MILLAGE FOR ROAD
REPAIR, MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT**

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents and taxpayers of Middlebury Township to provide funding for repair, maintenance and improvements of the roads within Middlebury Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

Middlebury Township shall place on the ballot a Road Millage for the August election in 2016. The ballot request shall be for 2 mills per year for four years for the purpose of maintenance, repair and improvement of Middlebury Township roads with the following language.

Middlebury Township Road Millage 2016 Shall Middlebury Township continue to levy a two mill (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the Township of Middlebury, Shiawassee County, Michigan, for four years beginning with the 2016 tax levy year and running through the 2019 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy, estimated revenue of \$80,000.00, which shall be used for the specific purpose of road repairs and maintenance. If this millage is approved this will be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.

Motion was made by Trustee R. Semans and supported by Treasurer C. Stevens to adopt the foregoing resolution.
